

Health Insurance Struggles Loom

Legislature Opposes Showdown

SACRAMENTO, April 14.—(AP)—Mandatory health insurance, despite being one of the most controversial issues of the 1939 session, is moving toward a public hearing today as the Legislature studied a report from Culbert L. Olson urging passage of the legislation.

Opponents of the bill, chief of which is one by Assemblyman Ben Rosenthal of Los Angeles, will be heard at open sessions of the Assembly Unemployment Committee in the lower house rooms next Wednesday. All committee meetings for that date have been canceled.

Despite the opposition, passage of Rosenthal's bill removing the budget bill a \$200,000 appropriation for health insurance from the assemblyman Melvyn Cronin of San Francisco protested that if the Legislature sanctioned passage of the budget with this item, it would imply approval of the highly-disputed issue. Rosenthal's bill would be attached to the health bill.

In his message to the Governor in the Legislature he believed the average financial burden of the tax is well within the ability of employed wage earners, industry and society to meet.

Under the health insurance, under Rosenthal's bill, would be defrayed by joint State employer and employee contributions. The burden is being carried now in "piecemeal fashion," the Governor concluded, "but the results are characterized by disaster to the individual because sickness strikes him at an average force."
