Seven-Story 12,000 Scouts Launch Annual Goodwill Drive To Open Oct. 18

A seven-story, 400-car garage, designed by the local chapter of the Boy Scouts, is scheduled to open Oct. 18. The garage, located at Seventh and C streets, is the largest of its kind in the city. It will be operated by Metropolitan Industries, Inc., a subsidiary of the city of San Diego. The garage will provide parking for Scouts and their families, as well as for the general public. The garage is expected to generate significant revenue for the city and the Scouts.

The garage is dedicated to the memory of the late Mayor James D. Harter, who was instrumental in its construction. The garage is expected to be a major landmark in the city and a source of pride for the community.

Each entrance and exit is a seven-minute drive. A dedicated ticket machine will provide parking tickets. Rates are \$1.00 for Scouts and \$1.50 for the general public. There will be no cross traffic.

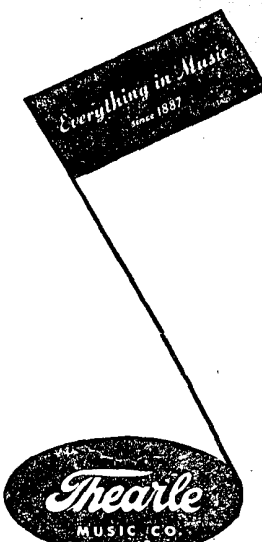

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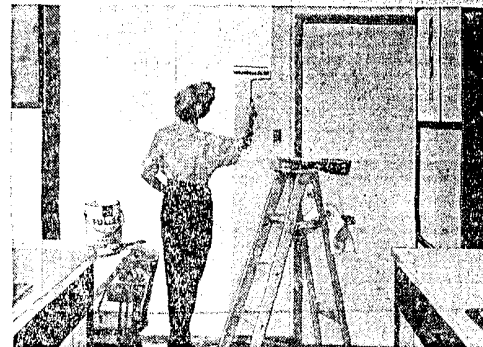
