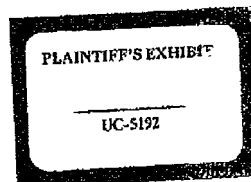
We are puzzled by their claim that Calidria RG-144 is non-carcinogenic. Have you ever heard of an asbestos that was non-carcinogenic?
