I do not believe for a moment that the symptoms which you describe are in any way the result of lead poisoning but I am taking the liberty of sending your letter to Dr. R. A. Kehoe of the University of Cincinnati who is an authority in this field and am requesting him to reply to you directly.

I may say that Ethyl Gasoline should be used as a motor fuel only and we do not advise its use in cigar lighters.
