In short, Lorraine is correct and the original intention was for a separate Fudan/API contract to help with the CC study (for getting patients for the CC study, interviews and data entry). Even if Rich intends to provide support for the CC study with respect to interviews, etc, there is still a need for some separate arrangement with Fudan for independent QA/QC of this work.

I heard you were selected on Monday's OC call to research the need for the API contract directly with Fudan (Dr. Fu). Below is an old email exchange I had with Rob Schnatter and Otto Wong about the scope of work for a contract extension with Fudan. (I seemed to have lost Rob's note but he was OK with the current scope of work.)

Lorraine told me that the need was created because the contract between UCHSC and Fudan only covered the molecular epi and disease progression protocols. Who was going to interview the control subjects or NHLs? Apparently the UCHSC/Fudan contract did not cover travel expenses to SHS annual meetings either.

That's what I know.

Dear Russ:

Sorry for the delay in getting back to you on this. I was traveling. I am actually working in Shanghai right now. It has been raining ever since I came here. It's messy and impossible to find a taxi when it rains, but at least it's not hot and muggy.

I looked over Fudan's invoice carefully and agree with you that all the items are necessary to support the CC study. In terms of any possible additions, I would suggest the following:

- 1) Perhaps a little bit more time for the "data handler." I can anticipate that more time will be needed in handling data in 2007.
- 2) Make sure that both Professor Fu and Professor Liang have the necessary funds to travel to the US for a final meeting in 2007.

Thank you for letting me know that API will be working on our contract amendment in October. I look forward to receiving it.

By the way, at the meeting in Houston Dr. Irons requested that patient enrollment be extended from end of 2006 to mid-2007. Has that been approved? If so, we need to adjust the schedule and budget of the CC study as well. Please let me know the final outcome of Richard's request.
