Dear Mr. Lindsey:

I am writing to inform you that the Compliance Assurance and Enforcement Division of Region 6, United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") inspection of the Port of Corpus Christi on February 21, 2024, included a visit to your facility at 5500 Up River Rd evaluating the potential for Resource Conservation and Recovery Act ("RCRA") violations. Based on the inspection, EPA has determined no further action is required.

As part of the inspection process, your facility was issued an EPA identification number, referred to as an EPA ID#. That number is: TXR000078212. This number was assigned to document the inspection and no future action determination.
