

1 Which would mean if you had a sugar size
2 cube of lung tissue, size of a sugar cube, and you did
3 a digestion on that and found out how much asbestos
4 was in it, you would have 20 of these asbestos bodies,
5 which would be a single asbestos fiber coated with
6 iron and protein in a single cube of tissue.

7 Most women who never had history of exposure
8 to asbestos, we don't find any.

9 What I have always said, if I had a case of
10 an individual who had mesothelioma who had less than
11 that background, I could not attribute the
12 mesothelioma to that.

13 The problem is that I think the
14 mesothelioma, and I think this is well documented in
15 the literature, is a type of cancer caused by asbestos
16 which it takes very little asbestos to cause, and I
17 think that is well accepted, well proven.

18 So with respect to is there a safe level to
19 which a person could be exposed, I would say,
20 generally if I was in that situation, I would say no,
21 there isn't any safe level because it takes so little
