Graduates Hear Consul General

Batauli, consul of France at San Francisco, told graduates of the Monterey Defense Language Institute, West Coast (DLIWC), that it is important for American men and women to learn French overseas to be able to speak the language of their country. To illustrate this, he told of some of his experiences in other countries.

The commencement ceremony, conducted in the President's Hall, was attended by 100 representatives of the Army, Navy, Air Force and Marine Corps. 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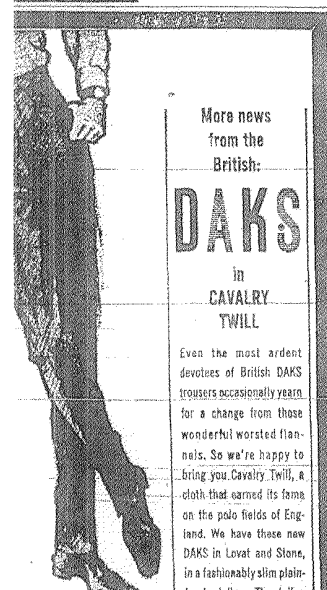
