Price \$75-0-0 per 2,000 lbs. f.o.b. steamship Fremantle, Australia. Total cost of the fibre \$1797-18-8 plus prepaid ocean freight \$116-11-6 plus U.S. Consul's fee \$10-15-10. Total amount of invoice in Australian Funds \$1915-5-4. (Conversion rate at \$3.2377 equals \$6,201.05). The price and extensions both are correct.

This invoice is approved for payment sight draft against bill of lading.

Included in the above shipment there is one drum of Blue Asbestos Ore, gross weight approximately 700 lbs., invoice marked "no commercial value". This is invoice No. A.B.A.-121 dated January 26, 1949, and we are retaining the memorandum invoice in our files.
