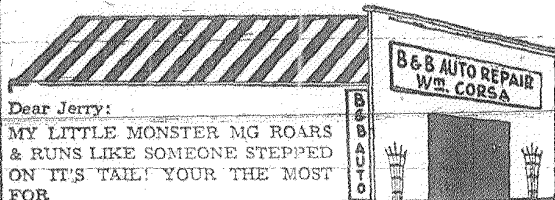

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Green, a bachelor, became the oldest man ever to serve in the Senate on June 17 last year. He was then 88 years, 8 months and 15 days old.

At that time the record for both houses was thought to have been held by the late Rep. Robert L. Doughton (D-NC), who was 89 years, 56½ days old when he retired from the House in 1953.

However a vigilant congressional researcher, Winant Ellmore, turned up with evidence that another North Carolina Democrat, Rep. Charles M. Stedman, died in office in 1930 at the age of 89 years, 7 months and 25 days.

Ellmore figured Green, born Oct. 2, 1867, would pass that record tomorrow. Others figured the date as today. One expert computed it to fall yesterday, Green reported.

"There are so many ways to figure it I don't know," he said. Don't Agree

He pointed out that the researchers did not agree on whether to take account of Leap Years and the day lost at the beginning of the century when there is no Leap Year.
