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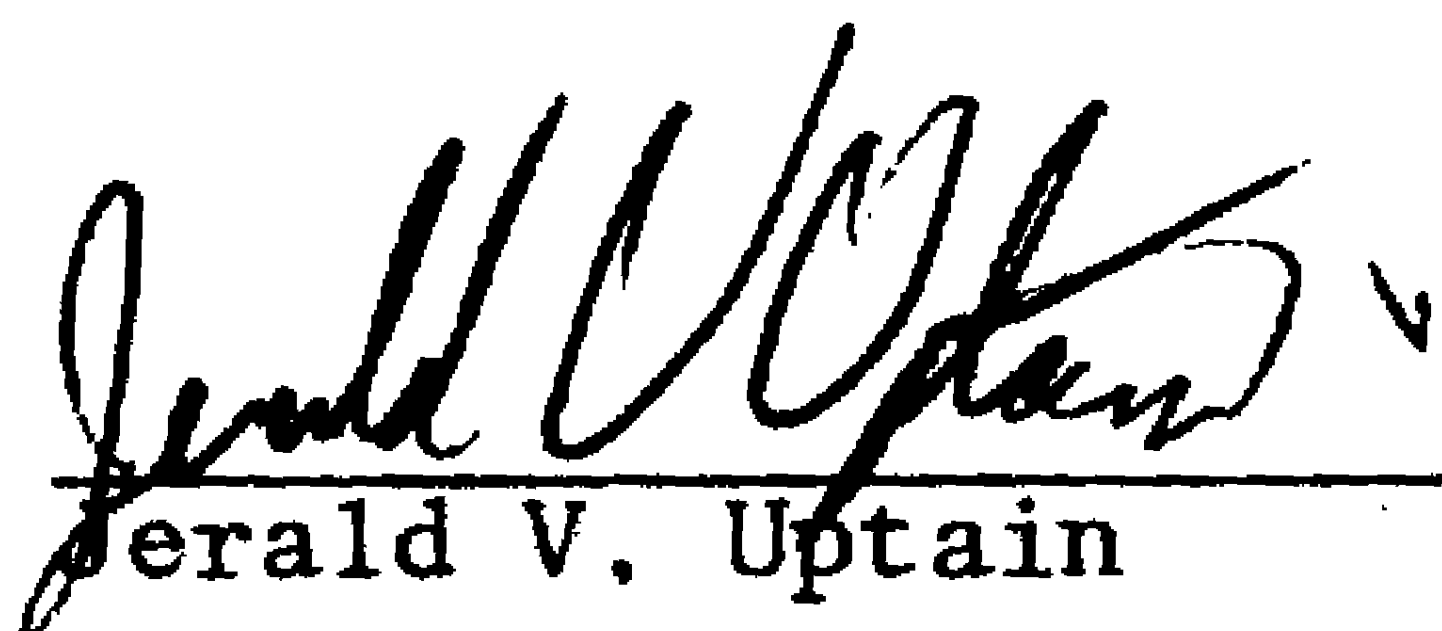

During your recent visit, you had some questions about the identification of the heavy metal chemicals in our PVC compounds. Following is a list of those chemicals:

- Dibasic Lead Stearate
- Dibasic Lead Phthalate
- Dibasic Lead Phosphite
- Lead Chromate
- Modified Lead Sulfate
- Modified Tribasic Lead Sulfate
- Antimony Trioxide
- Alkytin Mercaptoacid Ester
- Di (N-Butyl) Tin SS - Bis (Isoctyl Mercapto Acetate)

Identification of the barium, cadmium, zinc and antimony materials is less certain, most being listed as "complexes", "salts", or "proprietary" in nature.
