(b) Perform any studies or research into potential health hazards incident to the use of asbestos containing products.

(c) Review governmental publications of Great Britain toward the end of determining whether any research was being conducted by the British Government into any potential health hazards incident to the use of products containing asbestos.

(d) Review governmental publications of Great Britain to determine whether the Chief Inspector of Factories or any other British Government agency had issued any regulations or published any findings relative to potential health hazards incident to the use of products containing asbestos.

Without waiving this objection, Abex states that it is without sufficient knowledge and information to respond to this Interrogatory. Abex further states that to the best of current knowledge and belief, Abex Corporation was never a member of said Foundation.
