There will be an important meeting of all PVC/VCM Producers who are concerned with the new OSHA Standard for Vinyl Chloride and its impact on the production and distribution functions. As most of you know, there are far reaching ramifications stemming from this Standard some of which you may have already experienced.

The primary purpose of this meeting will be to discuss ways and means of coordinating and assisting common carriers, commercial warehousemen, and others to comply with their responsibility as imposed by the new OSHA Standard in order to assure that the industry will continue to receive such essential services. Other aspects of interpretation and compliance will also be reviewed.

This meeting will take place at the Washington Hilton, Connecticut Avenue at 14th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20004, on Wednesday, November 20th, 1974, at 10 a.m. sharp. Attendees should not plan to leave before 4 p.m.
