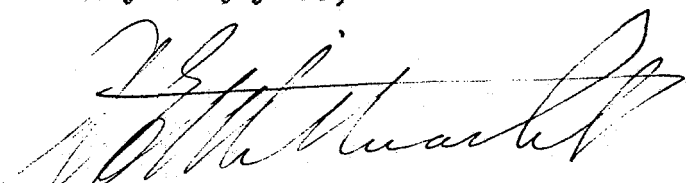
Gentlemen:
