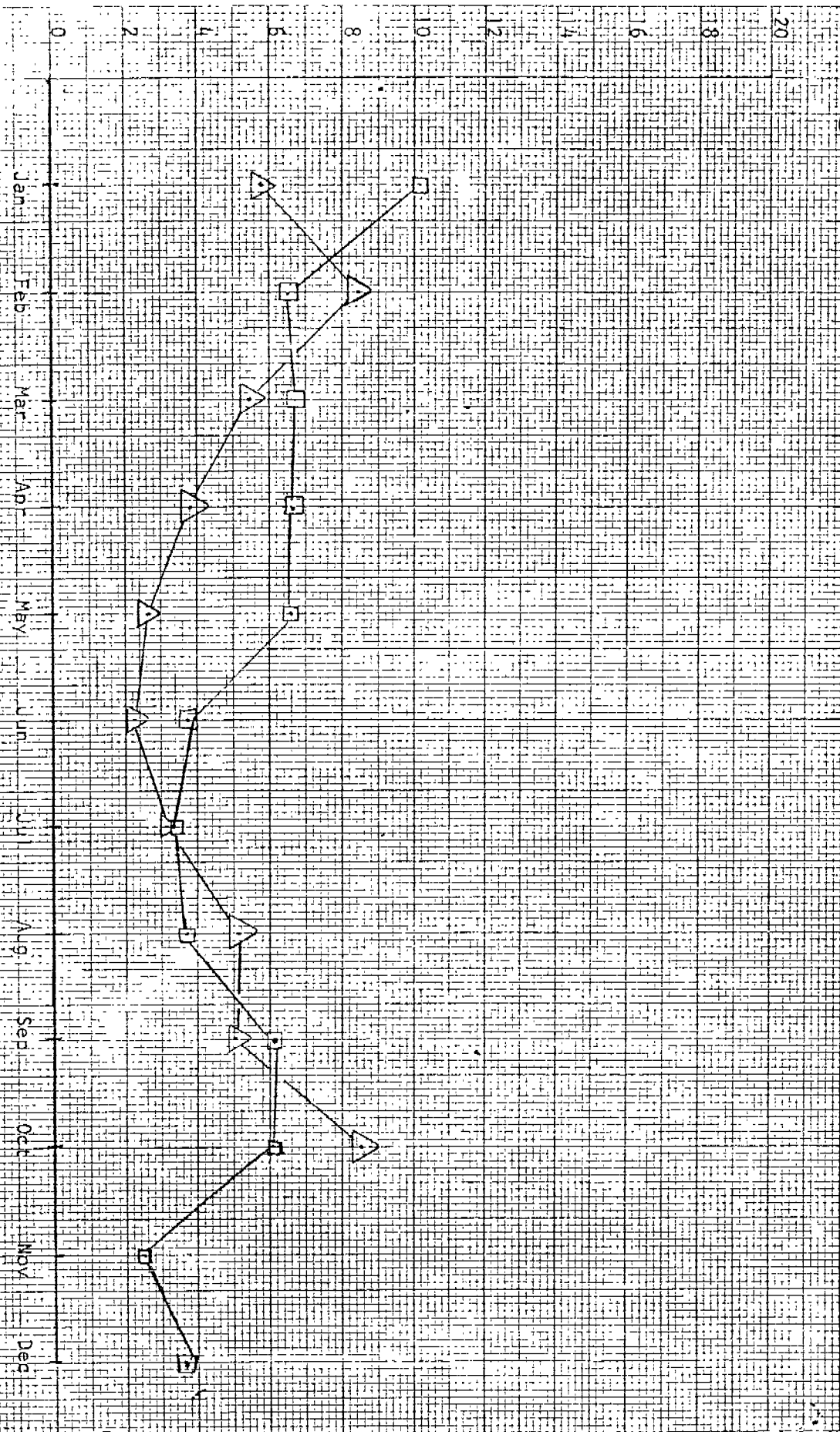

% READINGS GREATER THAN 1 PPM

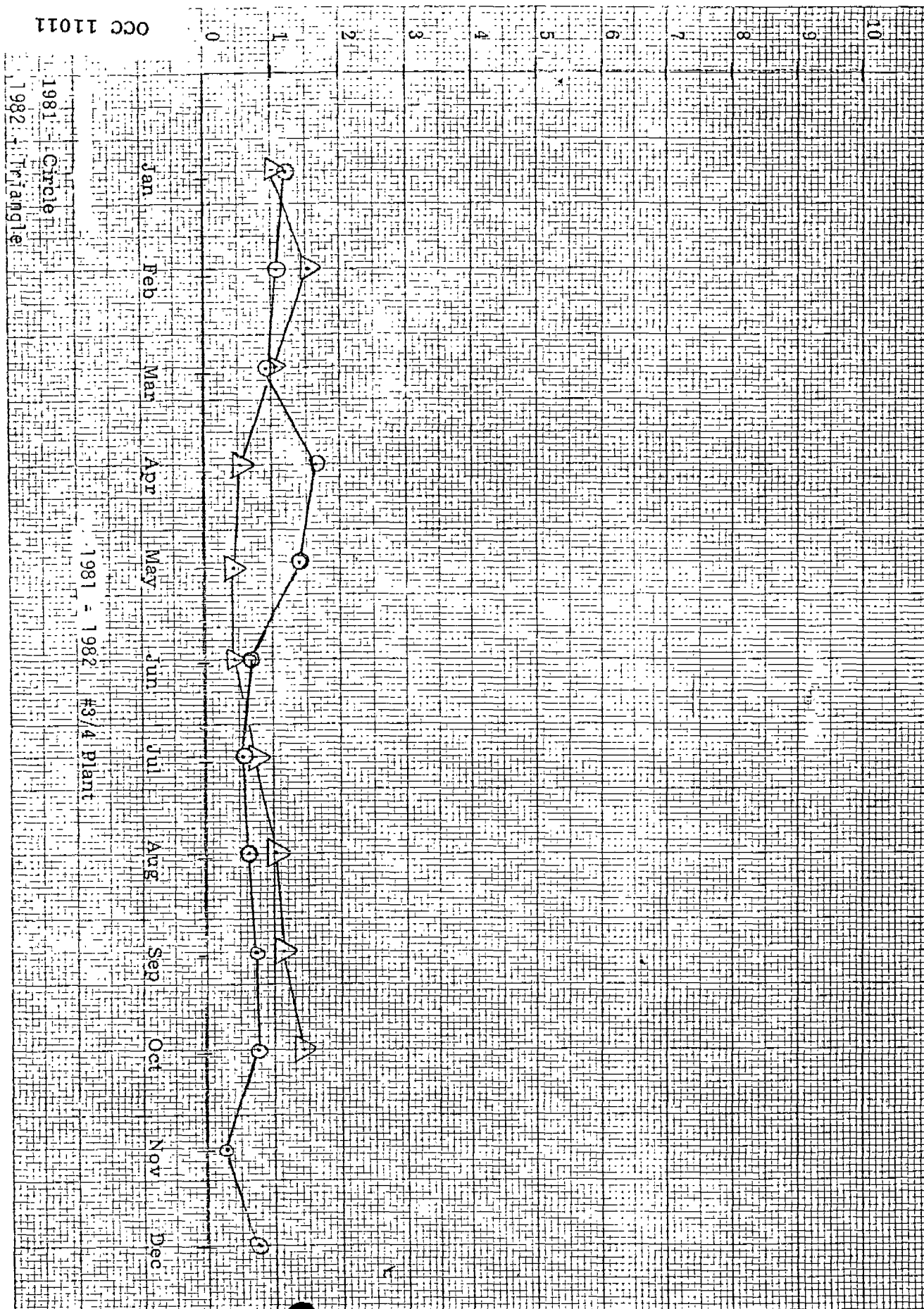
