

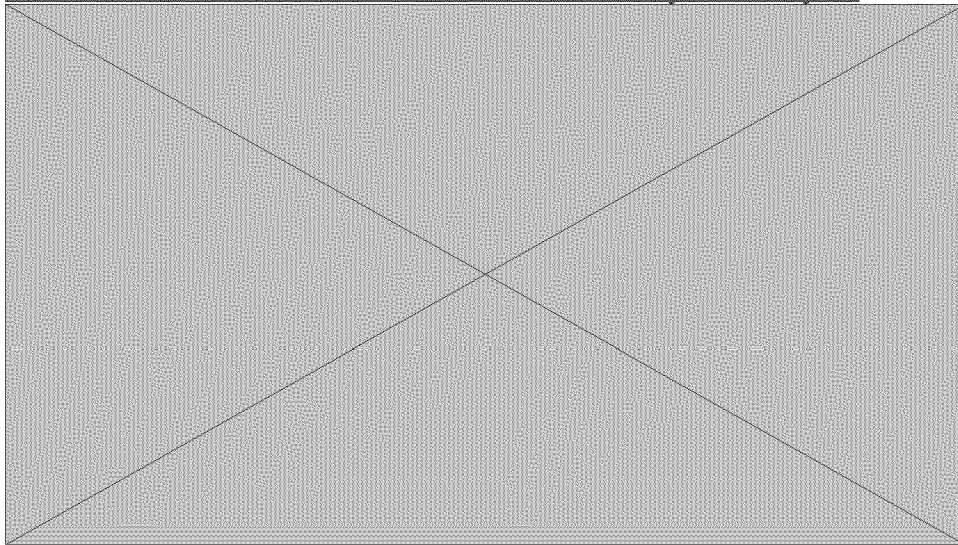

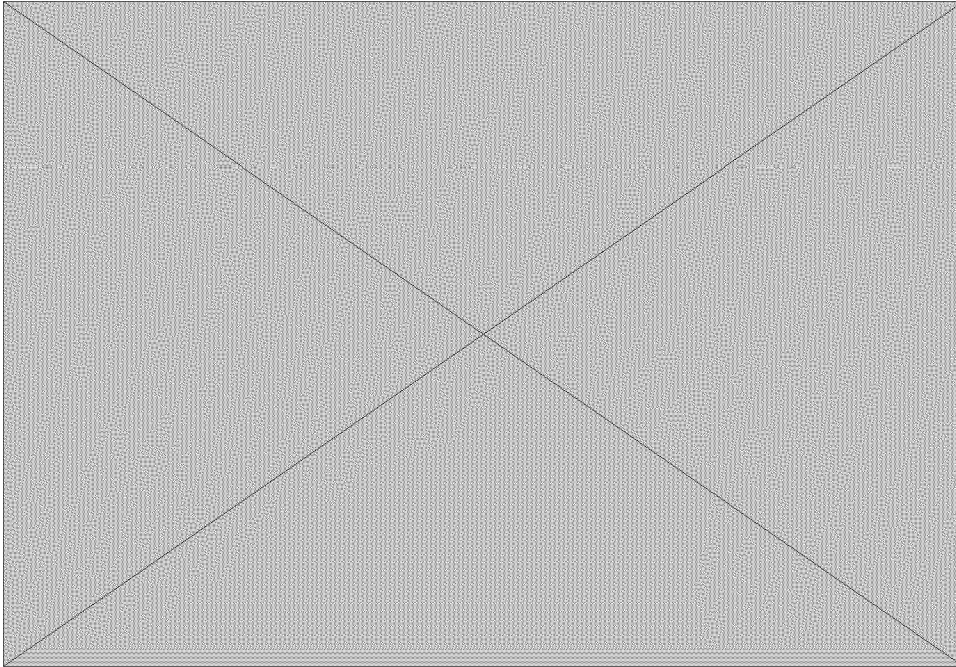

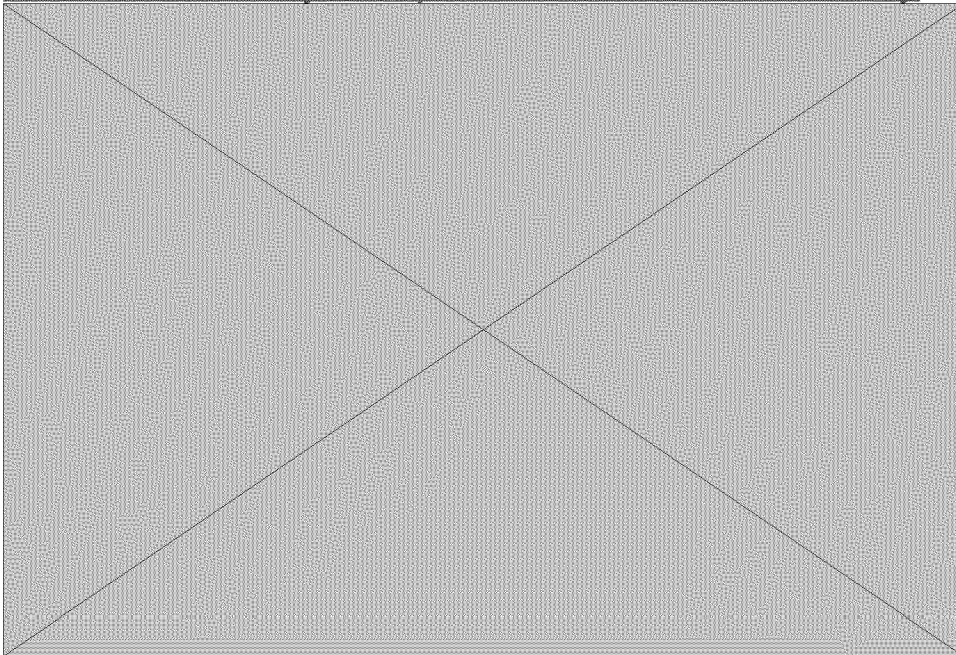

Income Volatility's Impact on Financial Security

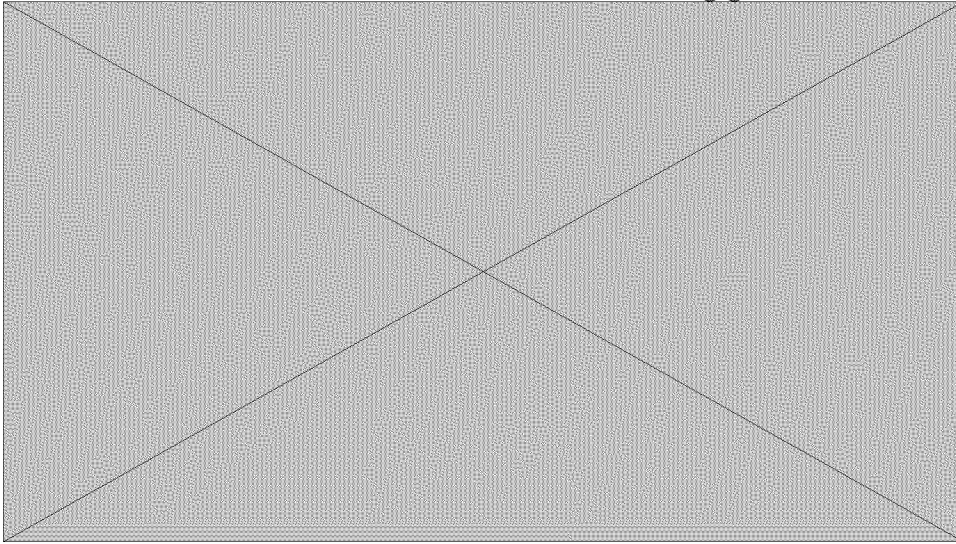


When annual income changes by 25 percent or more from year to year, it's

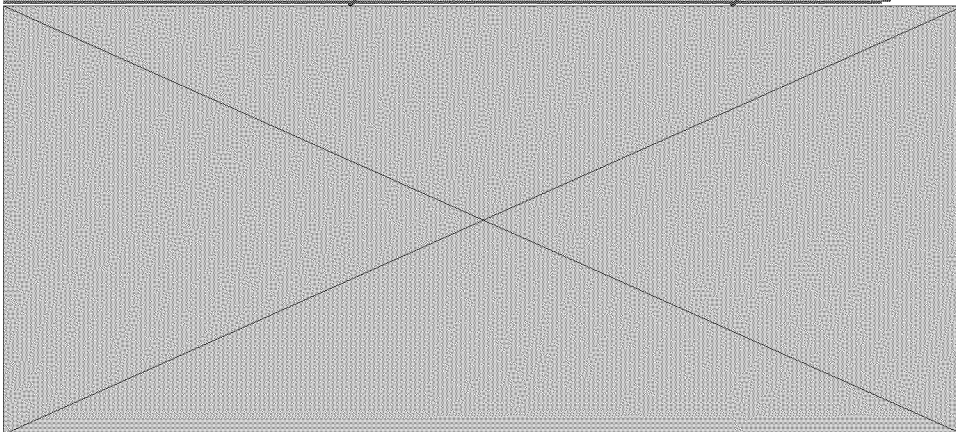
