I also saw the fluoropolymers in firefighting foams slide. I was already suspicious why Eurofer are so convinced that the C6 restriction by itself would be sufficient – a little bit too supportive of that restriction I said to myself!!

D4, D5 and D6 should be covered by the proposed restriction, which would also prevent that regrettable substitution.
