2. Was there an outcome of the Scientific Advisory Panel on glyphosate? I see the minutes online, but it's not clear to me if anything ever came of that?

3. Was that panel a public hearing? Or was it open only to invited scientists?

4. I know this is a touchy question, but can you provide any comment on the charges that EPA officials, and specifically Jess Rowland, were "colluding" with Monsanto to promote glyphosate as non-carcinogenic?
