KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the undersigned MONSANTO COMPANY
a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of
Delaware, in consideration of permission granted for
fire resistance testing (paragraph 4.4.1 of MIL-H-19457B (SHIPS))

by the U. S. Naval Ship Research and Development Laboratory and as
a precedent thereto, does hereby expressly agree to indemnify and
hold harmless the United States Government, its agencies and
instrumentalities against all suits, action, claims, cost or
demands (including without limitation, suits, actions, claims,
costs or demands for death, personal injury and property damage)
to which the Government, its agencies and instrumentalities may
be subject by reason of damage or injury (including death) to the
property or person of anyone, whomsoever they may be, arising from
the conduct by the U. S. Naval Ship Research and Development
Laboratory or by the undersigned, its agents, employees, or sub-
contractors in fire resistance testing (paragraph 4.4.1 of
MIL-H-19457B (SHIPS) on Turbinol 1223M
arising or resulting directly from the failure of Turbinol 1223M
to meet the undersigned's specifications therefor.

The undersigned hereby waives any and all claims which,
but for this waiver, it may have, or which it may hereafter acquire,
against the United States Government, arising out of the testing
hereinabove described, except such as shall have been caused by
the sole or concurring negligence of the United States Government
or its agencies or instrumentalities.
