Crane's National Parts Managers Meeting is tentatively scheduled for October in Tulsa. No suppliers have been invited as yet. Bob Stipes is still complaining about poor service out of Henderson. The Crane account will be reviewed to qualify his complaints.

H. TEREX

Terex has again requested an update on our ability to provide 2590 and 3910 parts. We are getting close on inventory on some parts.

I. TIMBERJACK

We are in a serious problem with some old style wheel reduction parts for Timberjack. Eaton manufacturing capability doesn't exist and out sourcing has been reviewed. We should be in a favorable position in October.

J. VOLVO WHITE
