Details:

We have the following information from newspaper clipping dated 5-21-55.

Charles Earl Arthur, 32, of Norfolk, Va., is accused of violating the Mann Act by allegedly transporting a woman across state lines for immoral purposes.

Arthur and another person were said to have gone to Raleigh, May 1, from Norfolk, Va. They were arrested Wednesday at the Carolina Hotel.

Local officers charged the woman with prostitution and the man with aiding and abetting in prostitution. At their appearance in City Court Solicitor Robert L. McMillan, Jr., took a nol pros with leave (dropped prosecution for the time being) and turned them over to federal officers.

The pair received a preliminary hearing in the office of the Wake County Jail shortly before noon. Failing to post \$1,000 bonds, they were committed to jail to await trial in Federal Court in Raleigh, N.C.
