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Dear All,

please find attached to this E-Mail the draft agenda including the WebEx details for the next monthly meeting 22 March.

In addition we have started the concrete time planning for the drafting of the Annex XV dossier backwards from an anticipated submission date on 1 July 2022 (please see attached Excel file). This resulted in setting deadlines for finishing the different parts of the Annex XV dossier and therefore for the work of different work packages taking into account the dependencies of different parts. A potential timing of a second CfE was added as a suggestion in the timeline.
