No New Cases Of Meningitis At Fort Ord

No new cases of meningitis have been reported at Fort Ord since preventive doses of sulfadiazine were administered to all permanent party and trainees the first week of this month, a Fort Ord spokesman said today.

The postwide dosage was ordered after 15 cases were reported during September on the base. The spokesman said the incidence of meningitis has been running higher at Fort Ord this year, just as it has throughout the state, starting last February. At no time, however, has it reached proportions that could be considered epidemic, he said.

All cases at the post have been among men in the two basic training brigades. More than 90 per cent of the cases turned up within the routine incubation period of the first 12 days, indicating that the men were infected before they arrived at the post, he said.

Six cases were reported in July and the sulfadiazine were given to all units at that time. In August there were only two cases. There have been no fatalities, and of the 15 who were ill last month, only six are still hospitalized. Recovery has been good and no indication of permanent injury has been noted, it was reported.

I personally despise totalitarian government in any form, Communist or otherwise. I'm totally opposed to all that Red China stands for and I intend to work for the day when all Chinese people are free and my opponent knows this.

Talcott's position:
 "I am firmly opposed to the replacement of our ally Nationalist China in the UN by the present Communist Chinese government as demanded by Red China, the Soviet Union and the other Communist satellite governments. If elected to Congress I would vote for a resolution demanding that the United States oppose the admission of Red China to the UN. (A two-thirds vote is required to admit.)

Talcott View
 "It would be detrimental to the cause of freedom in Asia and that means the whole world if we admit Red China. It is defiance of the United Nations in Korea. It defies the precepts of the UN with its belligerent attitude toward India. It certainly was violating all the principles of the US in what it did with Tibetans. . . .
