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SAN FRANCISCO, Oct. 24 (AP) — Federal assistance, in the opinion of Rega-Radin State Relief administration consultant, is the "only answer" to California's migrant relief problem.

"It is impossible for the SRA to help the dust bowl refugees now flooding the state," Miss Radin told 300 social workers last night. "We can only send them back to their native states if they are unable to find work."

The "migratory" agricultural workers, she said, are "a vital necessity to California farmers, who employ 46,500 migrants during the January slack season and 500,000 during the peak fall harvest."

"California can't exist without the migrants, and migrants can't exist without aid, and California can't supply the necessary funds," she said. "The only answer is federal assistance."
