In reply to your letter of February 8 please be advised that March 6, 7 and 8 can be made definite as dates for negotiations at your Owentown plant. Please advise me of the time and place you wish to commence.

Mr. Thomas W. Walker has been selected as the Chairman of the Pittsburgh Corning Group and I would appreciate it if you would favor him with a copy of all correspondence you send to me.

The Union employees of the plant have selected a grievance and negotiating committee called the Workmen's Committee ~~to~~ assist the Union in it's negotiations and in the handling of grievances. Will you please show them the courtesy commensurate with their position in the Union. Also, will you please relieve them from duty so that they can participate in the contract negotiations. Members of the Workmen's Committee are ~~Edd Land~~, Chairman, Jim Musick (*Shipping - Material Handl*) and Thomas W. Walker (*Shipping - Warehouse man*).

With regards to the employee benefit plans, it would simplify things if you would just send me copies of each. You are also requested to send me as agent for the employees three copies of the current reports (Form D-1 with Plant attached, and Form D-2) which your company is required to file with the U. S. Department of Labor under the Pensions and Welfare Plan Disclosure Act. As you may know, the Company is required to furnish this to any employee upon request.
