7 As requested, an industrial hygiene study
8 was conducted to evaluate worker exposure to asbestos
9 dust in the brake research unit located at the
10 scientific building, research and engineering center.

11 The operations carried on in the brake
12 research unit include the weighing and compounding of
13 dry asbestos, cutting, filing -- and there is an
14 illegible portion in the original document -- wear
15 testing of the compound asbestos brake lining
16 material.

17 Only one of the rooms is equipped with
18 process exhaust ventilation, while the other rooms
19 have normal building general ventilation.
