For use against Steam, Water, Air, Oil, Petroleum, Electricity, Acetylene, Gases and Chemicals, and Acts not destructive to load.
Packs All Stuffing Boxes on ALL kinds of engines.
FOLLOWING UP
When placed in place, lock it off and all box work is done, and complete. (DO NOT REMOVE THE ALLPAX IN PLACE.)
REMOVING ALLPAX
If for any reason it is desired to remove the stuffing box, blow ALLPAX out with pressure, or pull it out the same way as the rest of the packing.

THE PACKING THAT "PACKS ALL"

INSTALLATION OF ALLPAX
Remove all old packing from the stuffing box. Fill box to box with ALLPAX, packing it down with a stick or a blunt tool and the gland as you go along. Pack to seating on glands. Loosenen right with gland. Back off gland and all box to face again. Continue with gland pulling, up on both ends through the center a light compression in the box. No further pressure is required until lock up shown. Then tighten down as required.
Do not be afraid to get too tight. ALLPAX is lubricating and will loosenen. IF WILL NEVER RISK! Box trouble are obtained with ALLPAX when the gland is kept loose against the packing.
No lock rings are required with ALLPAX. Remove when equipment is badly worn.
ALLPAX compresses into 47 to 55 cubic inches per pound.

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
