NEFFERINO Panluis runs his thumb down the list of names, his forehead crinkled with concentration. "Stand... he died a couple of months ago. I went to the funeral. Antonio... he's sick, very sick."

Prisoners from Werribee are typical of the 2,500 people who are locked in one of the nation's 100 prisons. Most are men, many of them from Australia's inner-city, inner-suburban working-class areas.
