Dear Dr. Kehoe:

I know that you are interested in the New York City situation with reference to the distribution of Ethyl Gasoline and am therefore enclosing a copy of a resolution recently adopted on the subject by the Board of Health.

We have always been on the defensive in an effort to explain the continued existence of the old resolution whenever we were questioned about it, and this has not been infrequently, so that the rescinding resolution should not only help us here but act to our advantage in those foreign countries where competitive propaganda has often pointed to the ban in this City. This has frequently been done to indicate that there was a doubt as to the possible ill effects in congested areas.
