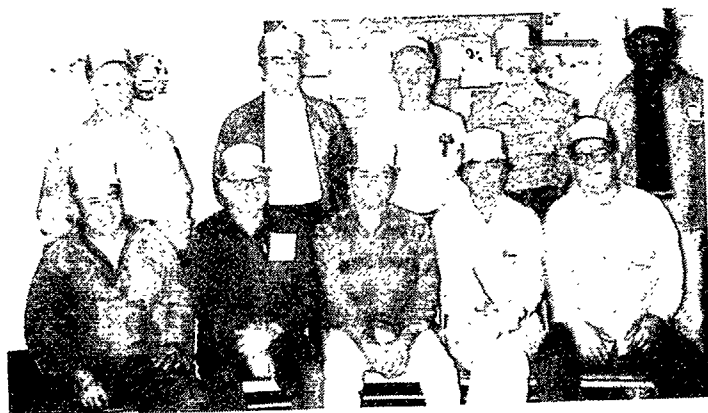

Hobo Dinner

- 2 pounds hamburger meat
- 1 onion, sliced
- 1 bell pepper or jalapenos sliced
- 1 package longhorn cheese
- 4 large potatoes
- 4 large carrots

Make 8 hamburger patties. Arrange sliced bell peppers or jalapenos on 4 of the patties. Place onion slices over peppers, then top each with a large slice of the cheese. Sprinkle with salt and pepper and place remaining 4 patties on top. Seal by pinching edges of patties together. Season with salt and pepper. Place in a large foil-covered baking sheet. Slice potatoes and carrots and arrange around meat patties. Cover with foil and bake at 300 to 350 degrees F. for 45 minutes to an hour.
