Dear Ms. Jones,

I hope this finds you well. I am a freelance journalist writing a piece about coalbed methane for *Climate Home News*. I left a voicemail, as well, but please find several questions listed below.

If the EPA would like to provide answers for this story, I would need those by noon on Wednesday to guarantee they meet my deadline. Because this is not a breaking news story, there is a chance that the story gets held a few days for edits. Because of that, please feel free to pass along any responses that come in after noon on Wednesday, and I will still try my best to get them in the story if it is not published yet.

--Is the EPA continuing research and/or data collection regarding coalbed methane? If so, which aspects of this topic are being researched?

--Is the "coalbed methane outreach program" still active, and what are its current efforts?

--What international efforts are ongoing to engage with foreign governments, agencies, etc. on the topic of coalbed methane?

--The EPA has released several reports into the areas where coalbed methane has the highest potential for capture. Are there ongoing efforts in the agency to promote capture at these or other coal operations?

--Are there ongoing partnerships with industry members or others to curtail coalbed methane emissions?
