Dear Mr. Torre,

Your letter of November 17 addressed to Mr. Finders, has been referred to me for attention.

I take it that Schulman Plastics' inquiry for dust-free asbestos filler refers to your RG-600, which Grace tentatively had agreed to market as SYLODEX-60.

However, please note that we recently came to an understanding with John L. Myers of your Calidria Asbestos Division, Niagara Falls, that Union Carbide will, in fact, market this product themselves, whilst Grace will continue to market SYLODEX-14 and 24 (your RG-144 and 244).

John Myers told me that Julian Weil, UCC Geneva, is involved in evaluating the market potential for RG-600. May I therefore suggest that you pass on subject inquiry to Mr. Weil for handling.

We shall be more than pleased to forward a sample from our Milan office, where we still maintain about 60 kilos in stock.
