MINE STAFF. The attached letter in connection with the advertisement for a Mine Manager and which is self-explanatory, was received by me. I have not replied to the request and no copy of the letter has been kept.

Mill Superintendent. At the first opportunity it is our intention to appoint a mill foreman or Superintendent in place of I. Dignam, but before doing so we would be pleased to know if you have anyone in mind for this position.

In some directions Dignam has remarkable mechanical ability and can be a most valuable employee if given the right type of work but we should be able to improve on him as regards a mill superintendent. It is my intention to confine Dignam to general fitting, maintenance of motor vehicles and outside work. He has exceptional ability in regard to motor vehicles and on outside work requiring initiative.

When examined by the travelling laboratory some months ago Mr Dignam showed signs of Asbestosis and it is probably advisable to get him away from the dust for a time if at all practicable.

Nothing shall be done in this connection until we have your comments.
