5 know about today in 1996. I am going to call it
6 latency, and I know you refer to it as cumulative

11 We knew about that in 1930, too, didn't we?

12 A Not in the way we understand it now, but
13 there was a concept similarly.

14 Q Dr. Merewether in 1930 when he was writing
15 his article, he was talking about maturation of harm
16 and that is what he is talking about?

17 A Talking about a dose response. The
18 cumulative nature of the dose is what really snuck up
19 on medicine and science.

20 Q Dr. Merewether, when he wrote his article,
21 he also included discussions about dose and time,
