In the single-wheeled machine, which is pulled by an automobile, are two dials—one which indicates the roughness of the pavement in inches per mile and another which makes a graph of the roughness.

Oakland's best street has 60 inches of roughness per mile, while the worst street has 300 inches of roughness per mile, according to H. S. Kaulbach, city maintenance engineer.

Kaulbach said that the city's roughest streets are scheduled for immediate repair. He pointed out

Oakland has resurfaced about 100 miles of streets in the last 10 years, most of them in the residential areas.
