

3. "SYMMETREL" - By now, I am hopeful that the Pharmaceutical Division of our I. & B. Department, has sent each of you a packet of information regarding "Symmetrel", Du Pont's new anti-influenza drug. I wish to stress to each of you that this drug is for the prevention of influenza, and not a cure. It appears to be effective primarily against the A2 strain.
