REPORTING AND PROGRESS REPORTS

A. During the pendency of this Decree, Conoco and Vista shall submit directly to EPA copies of all semiannual, quarterly, and relief valve discharge reports which are required to be submitted by the applicable laws and regulations to the State of Louisiana pursuant to EPA delegation of the NESHAP program to the State. Defendants shall also include in the semiannual reports all discharges, leaks, and/or emissions reported to the National Response Center pursuant to the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act ("CERCLA"). Conoco and Vista are

~~each obligated to submit these reports only for the period of time during which each owned and operated or continues to own and operate the EDC/VC plant.~~

~~B. Commencing on the first calendar quarter after entry of the Plan as an addendum to this Decree, Conoco and Vista shall also submit quarterly progress reports within fifteen (15) days of the end of such quarter detailing all~~
