WHO DESIRE THEM WITHOUT COST TO THE EMPLOYEES.

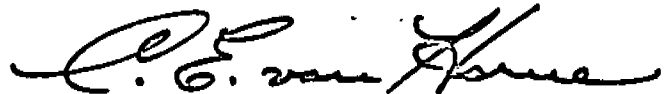
ARRANGEMENTS WILL HAVE TO BE MADE WITH A LOCAL HOSPITAL AND
