In reply to your letter of December 3, the apparent difficulties concerned with tank cleaning at the R.C.A.F. station at High River, Alberta, probably resulted from inadequate ventilation with diminished oxygen supply and increased carbon dioxide content of the air. Atmospheric conditions of this nature could readily produce symptoms complained of by the men.
