Further evaluation of the available mica for NF-128-D shows that we will consume about 2,100 lbs. of the 2,500 lbs. of Dark -10 mica requested in the reference letter. To produce the required Dark -7 blend, we request:

1. That you prepare a 5600 lb. blend containing:

4200 lbs. Dark 10 PA-1 Mica
 1400 lbs. Dark 2 " "

This should be made as two 2800 lb. blends which are then reblended to one 5600 lb. blend.

2. We will use this blend to establish the best process in the semi-works which may include:

- (a) Using one-half the blend and returning the other half to you.
- (b) Dry classifying the blend and returning 50% to you with roughly 10% fines rather than the original 5%. This is probably directly usable, with additional Dark 2 mica, for NF-123-D.

We would like to have this blend as soon as possible in order to meet our goal date of making the NF-128-D plant batch in mid March.
