Dear Mr. Greschaw:

On January 30, 1976, two bulk talc samples were submitted by you to this laboratory for asbestos analysis.

Sample BX-128, a Montana Talc, showed no chrysotile or amosite on the X-ray Diffraction, and no fibers were detected by Phase Contrast Microscopy.

Sample Nyral-200, a New York Talc, showed no chrysotile or amosite on the X-ray Diffraction, but fibers were observed under the Phase Contrast Microscope.
