4 jury what the doctor said back in April of '81.

5 A This is a note by Dr. Heyman. He thinks
6 that the abdominal girth may have increased somewhat,
7 and he thinks the umbilical nodule is larger. He
8 notices shortness of breath only with vigorous
9 exertion.

10 Do you want me to read the rest of this
11 highlighted?

12 Q If you would, please.

13 A He has invaded transient back discomfort
14 when sitting in one position for any prolonged period
15 of time.

16 He has no significant abdominal discomfort,
17 nausea, vomiting, melena, or hematochezia.

18 Q That is fine, Doctor. What does that mean?
19 What do those two terms mean you just read
20 to the jury?
