Dear Mr. Kelly:

I wonder if it would be possible for you to send me a copy of the autopsy report, including microscopic examinations, of the lungs of your patient Mr. Dennis Cleary. Also a description of his symptoms and the chest x-ray reports prior to his death.

You will recall that I have discussed this matter with you before and you are aware of our interest in these cases exposed to vermiculite dust from the Public Health standpoint. Of course, you are well aware that we have no interest in workmen's compensation claims and any legal matters concerned with these cases. We are interested from the medical standpoint to improve medical knowledge of a possibly hazardous dusty occupation and to suggest proper means of controlling the hazard.
