APPLICATIONS

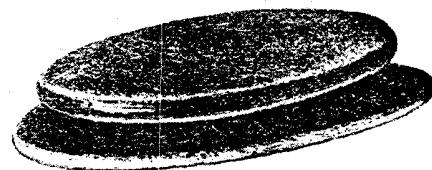

CONSTRUCTION

The twin side-placed filters, which assure low breathing resistance, are connected to a durable rubber facepiece with soft, flexible inturred edge—fitting any face with a comfortable air-tight seal.
