Dear Ivans:

I am very glad to have your note of June 14th and to know that you think well of the arrangement to have the young man from the University of Montreal go to Thetford Mines this summer. It also pleases me to know that you are looking forward to Dr. Lanza's visit. Dr. Lanza tells me that he will arrive in Toronto the morning of June 24th and will be there until the evening of the 27th when he goes to Montreal. He expects to be in Montreal the 28th and 29th. He is planning to get in touch with you on his arrival in Montreal. May I suggest that you drop him a note advising him of the most convenient way to communicate with you on his arrival.
