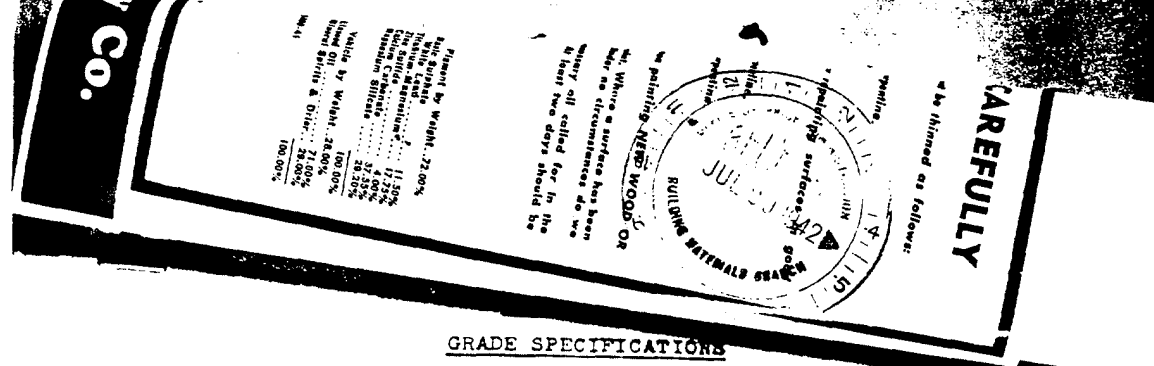

* The highest price at which this Paint was sold in March 1942 was \$2.49 per gallon, but the bulk of sales were made by way of an advertising offer at \$1.74 per gallon. From the latter figure should be deducted 20 percent sales commission and 25 cents per gallon freight which we prepaid, bringing the realized price down to \$1.14 per gallon.
