Function Data

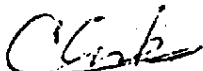
Dear Doctor,

You asked me to send you some guide lines for reviewing the test results from the Pulmonary Function Screen. There are two sheets enclosed. I hope that these will be sufficient for the first time. As indicated, serial testing produces much more information. (One company is asking us to come back in a six month interval for some follow-up testing with out the Van.)

As you know, we will be continually trying to improve our equipment, e. g. 3-channel Electrocardiogram system and the Pulmonary Function Analyzer and Recorder, and our services. You can help me from the medical and professional service point of view. You as a professional, could ask the two groups of doctors - those interpreting the X-Rays and those reading the ECG charts - what their evaluations are pertaining to quality, record keeping, communications (before, during and after testing) and our attitude. This and any other suggestions will be most welcome.

In advance, I want to thank you and Bob Douglas for the cooperation extended to our crew and for the letters that you will write to Connecticut and to Mrs. Rosemary Rowe (a "testimonial" letter that she can use in her contacts with other companies in your area).
