We are currently using your product Aroclor 5460 in our manufacturing operations.

Some of our products are sold to customers whose applications involve contact with foods. Since your products may contain a number of chemical substances of which only you are aware, we would like a current statement from you in regard to the status of your products under the Food Additive Regulations which are administered by the Food and Drug Administration. We are aware that you can certify only your product and not our application of your product.

It would be very helpful if you could provide me with a written answer to the questions below so that we may better assess the status of our products.

1. Is your product listed in the Food Additive Regulations under its chemical name, and if so, which regulations?
2. Do you consider your product to be safe for use in contact with foods, and if so, subject to what limitations of chemical concentration and with what limitations on the type of food being contacted?
3. Do you have available and can you furnish detailed information relating to the toxicity, physiological, and biological effects of your product?
4. If you consider your product to be suitable for use in contact with foods, does this consideration take into account any additives or impurities which may be present in your product as delivered?
